

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY REDUCTION IN
PAYMENTS TO AVOID PROSECUTION FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS**

ORIGINAL

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: During the period beginning on February 3, 2004 and continuing through and including March 15, 2004, the following reduction in payments to avoid prosecution is hereby established for overdue payments on all violations of the parking regulations of the Village of Oak Park issued prior to January 1, 2004 to reduce the backlog of unpaid parking citations, assist in the change over to a new parking enforcement computer system and thereby enhance enforcement of the Village's parking regulations.

SECTION 2: Payments to avoid prosecution for all violations of the parking and vehicle license regulations of the Village of Oak Park, which have not been paid within ten (10) days of the issuance of each citation, shall be temporarily reduced to the original fine amount imposed for each such violation during the above stated time period. The amount of each payment to avoid prosecution for each category of parking violation, established by ordinance and in effect prior to February 3, 2004, shall be in effect on and after March 15, 2004.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.


