

## **RESOLUTION**

### **A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT OFFICERS FOR THE VILLAGE OF OAK PARK**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Oak Park (the "Village") is a public body that comes within the purview of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.* ("FOIA") and responds to requests made for public records under the FOIA; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 3.5 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/3.5, the Village shall designate its FOIA officer(s); and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Village Board of Trustees designate the following as the Village's FOIA officers: (1) the Village Clerk, primary; (2) the Village Attorney; and (3) the Police Records Supervisor.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

**Section 1. Recitals Incorporated.** The above recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

**Section 2. FOIA Officers Designated.** The President and Board of Trustees designate the Village Clerk, Village Attorney and Police Records Supervisor as the FOIA officers for the Village. The Village's FOIA Officers are directed to comply with all the provisions of the FOIA.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
