## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COOK COUNTY AND OTHER REGIONAL GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES FOR THE 2020-2025 ASSESSMENT OF FAIR HOUSING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,500 AND AUTHORIZING ITS EXECUTION

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Park ("Village") is an entitlement community under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and is therefore eligible to receive Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"); and

WHEREAS, in order to receive said grant funds, the Village is expected to affirmatively further fair housing, which can include submitting to HUD an Assessment of Fair Housing, which replaces the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice; and

WHEREAS, HUD encourages local entities to collaborate on a regional Assessment of Fair Housing, and because collaboration offers potential benefits such as being able to more efficiently and effectively meet federal fair housing requirements and realize a cost savings; and

**WHEREAS,** Cook County, in partnership with other regional governmental entities, has requested that the Village join such a regional collaboration pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:

- **Section 1. Recitals Incorporated.** The above recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth.
- **Section 2.** Approval of Intergovernmental Agreement and Execution. The Intergovernmental Agreement with Cook County and other regional governmental entities for a regional Assessment of Fair Housing for an amount not to exceed 3,500 to be paid with CDBG administration funds is approved and the Village Manager is authorized to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form attached.
- **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its adoption and approval as provided by law upon the approval of the Amended Plan referenced herein.
