Description of Work

Name: Lake Street and Forest Avenue Traffic Signal Improvements

Location: Lake Street and Forest Avenue

Proposed Improvement: In general, the improvements at Lake Street and Forest Avenue include the installation of underground galvanized steel conduit, handholes, double handholes, electric cable in conduit, light pole foundations, traffic signal foundations, controller foundations, fiber optic innerduct, PVC sleeving, class D patches, and fire hydrant removal and installation, and all appurtenant work thereto.

Bidders Instructions

No plans will be issued to prospective bidders after 4 P.M. on the working day preceding the opening of bids. Proposals will not be accepted by the Village of Oak Park from Contractors who have failed to provide payment, if required, for obtaining proposal forms and have also failed to register with the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department as plan holders for this project.
