

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FOR REPLACING SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING UNITS AND TWO NEW POWER LOAD SYSTEMS INCLUDING COTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$34,657.60

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, State of Illinois ("Village"), in the exercise of their home rule powers, that the Village is authorized to submit an application with the Federal Emergency Management Agency for an Assistance to Firefighters Grant for replacing self-contained breathing units and two new power load systems including cots in the amount of \$34,657.60 and the Village Manager or the Village Manager's designee is authorized to execute any and all documents in furtherance of the application and grant.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
