

RESOLUTION

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A BILL OF SALE FOR THE VILLAGE OF OAK PARK'S CANINE POLICE DEPARTMENT DOG KNOWN AS "ZEKE" DUE TO ZEKE'S RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Park's ("Village") Police Department has determined to retire the Police Department's canine Dog known as "Zeke" due to Zeke's age of eight (8) years; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Village and the Fraternal Order of Police Oak Park Lodge #8, the Village's Canine Officer shall have the first option to have ownership transferred to the Canine Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Village's current Canine Officer, Nathaniel Lietl, wishes to purchase Zeke pursuant to the Bill of Sale attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village Board must authorize such sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The above recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance and shall have the same force and effect as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Sale of K-9 Dog Authorized. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village Board Approves the Bill of Sale attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and authorizes the sale of the canine dog known as Zeke to Canine Officer Nathaniel Lietl due to Zeke's retirement.

Section 3. Authorization to Execute the Bill of Sale. The Village Manager is authorized to execute the Bill of Sale in substantially the form attached.

Section 4. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Oak Park are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval, passage and publication as provided by law.
