The E Series is now labeled as a legacy<br>product which means Zoll will no longer update the product to<br>be equipped to handle the new technology that our surrounding<br>hospitals are upgrading to receive 12 leads transmission from<br>our current monitors. Staff recommends replacing the monitors<br>with the same brand (Zolls) due to short learning curve and<br>reduces the chances for errors or delay in patient care. The two<br>E Series monitor purchased in 2012 will be replaced in 2020<br>with Zoll X Series monitor. |
