RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING VILLAGE OF OAK PARK GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM <u>DATA FROM THE COOK COUNTY ASSESSOR'S OFFICE</u>

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Park ("Village"), pursuant to the Illinois Highway Code, 605 ILCS 5/1 et seq. (the "Act"), is granted all powers necessary to carry out its legislative purposes as to the construction, operation, regulation and maintenance of its system of streets and alleys; and

WHEREAS, the Village is constantly evaluating and accessing tax parcel and street and alley network information/attributes that are adjacent to the streets and alleys; and

WHEREAS, the Cook County Assessor's Office has a geographic information system ("GIS") database that it is willing to make available to the Village at no cost pursuant to the "Not-for-Profit Database Subscription Agreement" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference ("Intergovernmental Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, GIS data sharing with the Cook County Assessor's Office ("Assessor") will allow the Village to access GIS data from the Assessor that will facilitate the Village's decision making process with respect to managing and maintaining its streets and alleys; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*, authorize units of local government to contract or otherwise associate among themselves to obtain or share services, to exercise, combine or transfer any power or function, in any manner not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, the Village and the Assessor are public agencies as that term is defined in the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*, and are thus authorized to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement.

- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, State of Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:
- **Section 1. Recitals Incorporated.** The above recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance and shall have the same force and effect as though fully set forth herein.
- **Section 2.** License Request. The Village hereby requests from the Assessor access to and license to use certain geographic information system data as provided by the Assessor. Said data is described in the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto.

Section 3. Approval of Intergovernmental Agreement. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village and the Assessor is hereby approved in substantially the form attached.

Section 4. Execution of Intergovernmental Agreement. The Village Manager and the Village Clerk are directed to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Village in substantially the form attached and any and all other documents in furtherance of the Agreement.

Section 5. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances, Resolutions and Motions. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Resolution. All ordinances, resolutions and motions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
