

1. The plans for the proposed work are those prepared by the Engineering Division of the Village of Oak Park, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois on **Thursday, July 2nd, 2020.**
2. The specifications referred to herein are those prepared by the Department of Transportation and designated as 2016 "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" and the "Supplemental Specifications" there to, the "Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Construction in Illinois", and the "Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices", adopted and in effect on the date of invitation of bids.
3. The undersigned agrees to accept, as part of the contract, the applicable Special Provisions indicated on the "Check Sheet for Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions" contained in this proposal.
4. The earliest the undersigned can begin work is two weeks AFTER the board approval date of Monday, August 3rd 2020, on **Monday, August 17th 2020.**
5. The undersigned agrees to substantially complete all work prior to **Friday, September 11th 2020**, with all punchlist items complete prior to **Friday, September 25th 2020**, unless additional time is granted in accordance with the specifications.
6. Approximately 1,000 SF of sidewalk identified as located around the elementary, middle, and high schools of Oak Park will be replaced on non-school days (weekends, holidays, or institution days).
7. Accompanying this proposal is either a bid bond on the Village Bond form or a proposal guaranty check, complying with the specifications, made payable to the Village of Oak Park. The amount of the check is 5% bid bond (\$ _____).
