The Village of Oak Park – Office of the Village Engineer, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302—will receive electronic proposals until **10:00 A.M. Thursday, August 20, 2020**. Bids will be received and accepted, and bid results posted via electronic VirtuBid™ online bid service.

Description of Work

Name: Water Main Valve Replacements

In general, the improvements consist of the removal and replacement of watermain valves ranging in size from 14 inches to 16 inches, including removal and replacement of valve boxes and valve vaults, watermain fittings, sidewalk, curb and gutter, and pavement replacement pavement or parkway restoration, and traffic control; and all appurtenant work thereto.

Bidders Instructions

1. Plans and proposal forms may be obtained via the electronic service starting on Thursday August 6th, at 4:00p.m., which can be found at <https://www.oak-park.us/your-government/budget-purchasing/requests-proposals> or at www.questcdn.com under login using QuestCDN number 7245401 for a non-refundable charge of \$30.00. Contractors must purchase bid documents and be shown on the Bidder's Planholder List in order to bid. Bids received from contractors who are not in the Bidder's Planholder List will be rejected. The Village of Oak Park reserves the right to issue plans and specifications to only those contractors deemed qualified. All prospective bidders must prove they are pre-qualified by the Illinois Department of Transportation by providing a certificate of eligibility to the Engineering Division at which time a password will be issued for access to the online bid documents. No plans will be issued to prospective bidders after **4 P.M.** on the wording day preceding the opening of bids. The electronic VirtuBid™ online bidding platform for this specific project will be opened approximately one week prior to the bid opening date.

2. At the bid opening, all proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the amount of 5% of the bid amount. The proposal guaranty shall be in the form of a bid bond executed by a corporate surety company or a bank cashier's check.
3. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute an agreement and contract bond within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award, it is hereby agreed that the bid bond or check shall be forfeited to the Village.
4. The awarding authority reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals as provided in Article 102.01 of the 2016 "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," prepared by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
