- The next Village Manager will have several challenges and opportunities to address, including managing affordability for both residents and business with regards to the Village's portion of the tax levy; facilitating courageous conversations related to racial justice and public safety; delivering on the Village Board's commitment to environmental sustainability; and developing systematic communication and engagement practices that facilitate consistent transparency and inclusion of all aspects of the Oak Park community. Other priorities include COVID recovery, internal succession planning, pension funding and small business engagement.
- The successful candidate will demonstrate tech savvy, servant leadership, and an understanding of economic development and intergovernmental affairs. It is crucial that the Village Manager possess well-developed communication skills and demonstrate a genuine regard for employees, community members, and Village partners and stakeholders.
