### **Agenda Item Title**

**An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3 (“Alcoholic Liquor Dealers”), Article 8 (“List of Licenses for Each License Class”), Section 3-8-2 (“Licenses by Name and Address Per License”) of the Oak Park Village Code for the Issuance of a Restaurant Class B-1 Liquor License to LMP Services, Inc., DBA Courageous Bakery**

### **Overview**

LMP Services, Inc., DBA Courageous Bakery (“Courageous Bakery”) seeks the issuance of a Restaurant Class B-1 liquor license for the property located at 736 Lake Street.

### **Recommendation**

Adopt the Ordinance.

### **Fiscal Impact**

Potential increase in alcoholic liquor dealer’s tax.

### **Background**

Courageous Bakery seeks the issuance of a Restaurant Class B-1 liquor license for the property located at 736 Lake Street. Courageous Bakery has been in operation since 2017 at that location and seeks to offer table service of brunch style drinks, cocktails and beer and wine through the issuance of a B-1 license. Courageous Bakery recently began offering full table service of food at its restaurant. At its special meeting of August 31, 2020, the Liquor Control Review Board (“LCRB”) found that Courageous Bakery met all of the applicable requirements for the issuance of a B-1 license and voted to unanimously recommend that the license be issued. Prior to the issuance of the license, the Village Code must be amended to include Courageous Bakery as a B-1 licensee.
