An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3 (“Alcoholic Liquor Dealers”), Article 8 (“List of Licenses for Each License Class”), Section 8-1 (“Number of Licenses Permitted to be Issued Per License Class”) and Section 3-8-2 (“Licenses by Name and Address Per License”) of the Oak Park Village Code for the Issuance of a Restaurant Class B-2 Liquor License to Munch, Inc., DBA Munch

Overview

Munch, Inc., DBA Munch (“Munch”) seeks the issuance of a Restaurant Class B-2 liquor license for the property located at 104 N. Marion Street.

Recommendation

Adopt the Ordinance.

Background

Munch seeks the issuance of a Restaurant Class B-2 liquor license for the property located at 104 N. Marion Street. Munch has been in operation at that location since 2011 as a vegetarian restaurant and seeks to add beer and wine table service through the issuance of a B-2 license. At its special meeting of August 31, 2020, the Liquor Control Review Board (“LCRB”) found that Munch met all of the applicable requirements for the issuance of a B-1 license and voted to unanimously recommend that the license be issued. Prior to the issuance of the license, the Village Code must be amended to include Munch as a B-2 licensee.
