### **Agenda Item Title**

**An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3 (“Alcoholic Liquor Dealers”), Article 8 (“List of Licenses for Each License Class”), Section 3-8-1 (“Number of Licenses to be Issued Per License Class”) and Section 3-8-2 (“Licenses by Name and Address Per License”) of the Oak Park Village Code for the Issuance of a Restaurant Class B-4 Liquor License to Nueva Era in Oak Park, Inc., DBA Altiro**

### **Overview**

The Ordinance authorizes the issuance of a Restaurant Class B-4 Liquor License to Nueva Era in Oak Park, Inc., DBA Altiro (“Altiro”) for the property located at 107 North Oak Park Avenue (“Property”).

### **Staff Recommendation**

Adopt the Ordinance.

### **Fiscal Impact**

Potential increase in alcoholic liquor dealer’s tax.

### **Background**

Altiro has applied for a Restaurant Class B-4 Liquor License at the Property. At its meeting on March 28, 2017, the Liquor Control Review Board (“LCRB”) determined that Altiro all of the applicable requirements for the issuance of the license and recommended that the Village Code be amended by a unanimous vote of its members in attendance so that the Local Liquor Control Commissioner may issue the license.
