### **Agenda Item Title**

**A Resolution Approving a Three-Year Professional Services Agreement with Thrive Counseling Center for Crisis Intervention and Other Police Social Work Services for 2017 - 2019 in an Amount not to Exceed \$141,000 Per Year and Authorizing its Execution**

### **Overview**

The Police Department uses contractual services to address crisis intervention and other social work services. The current contract will expire December 31, 2016.

### **Staff Recommendation**

Approve the Resolution.

### **Fiscal Impact**

This three year contract would begin on January 1, 2017 and conclude on December 31, 2019. The General Contractual account number 1001-42400-101-530660 has sufficient funds to cover this proposed agreement.

### **Background**

Competitive bids were opened on November 15, 2016 in response to a Request for Proposal (RFP) issued on October 18, 2016. The RFP was advertised in the local paper, on DemandStar and on the Village website. Two proposals were received. The low bid was submitted by Thrive Counseling Services. The current three-year contract that will expire on December 31, 2016 is also with Thrive Counseling Services.
