Agenda Item Title

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3 ("Alcoholic Liquor Dealers"), Article 8 ("List of Licenses for Each License Class"), Section 3-8-2 ("Licenses by Name and Address Per License") of the Oak Park Village Code for the Issuance of a Restaurant Class B-4 Liquor License to The Onion Pub and Brewery, Inc., DBA The Wild Onion Tied House

Overview

The Ordinance authorizes the issuance of a Restaurant Class B-4 liquor license to the Onion Pub and Brewery, Inc., DBA The Wild Onion Tied House ("The Wild Onion") for the property located at 1111 South Boulevard ("Property").

Staff Recommendation

Adopt the Ordinance.

Fiscal Impact

Potential increase in alcoholic liquor taxes.

Background

The Wild Onion has applied for a Restaurant Class B-4 liquor license for the property located at 1111 South Boulevard. At its meeting on February 28, 2017, the Liquor Control Review Board ("LCRB") determined that The Wild Onion met all of the applicable requirements for the issuance of a license and recommended that the Village Code be amended by a unanimous vote of its members so that the Local Liquor Control Commissioner may issue the license.
