### **Agenda Item Title**

**An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3 ("Alcoholic Liquor Dealers"), Article 8 ("List of Licenses for Each License Class"), Section 3-8-1 ("Number of Licenses to be Issued Per License Class") and Section 3-8-2 ("Licenses by Name and Address Per License") of the Oak Park Village Code for the Issuance of a Restaurant Class B-1 Liquor License to District Kitchen & Tap, Inc.**

### **Overview**

District Kitchen & Tap, Inc. ("District Kitchen") seeks the issuance of a restaurant B-1 liquor license for the property located at 200-222 Harrison Street.

### **Staff Recommendation**

Adopt the Ordinance.

### **Fiscal Impact**

Potential increase in alcoholic liquor dealer's tax.

### **Background**

District Kitchen seeks the issuance of a restaurant B-1 liquor license for the property located at 200-222 Harrison Street. At its meeting on October 24, 2017, the Liquor Control Review Board ("LCRB") found that District Kitchen met all of the applicable proposed requirements for the issuance of a B-1 license and recommended that the license be issued by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner. Prior to the issuance of the license, the Village Code must be amended to include Scratch as a B-1 licensee.
