## Agenda Item Title

An Ordinance Approving Changes to Meter Hours for On-Street Parking Spaces on the 800 Block of Lake Street

#### Overview

The Village received a request from the Hemingway District on behalf of the businesses at 803-805 Lake St to change metered parking spaces adjacent to their businesses with 3 hour time limits to 15 minute metered parking spaces. There are currently two 15-minute meters which were approved by Village Board action on December 5, 2016. This will bring the total to five

15-minute metered spaces on the 800 block of Lake Street. On June 16, 2017, the Village Board approved ORD 17-230, changing the parking meters with no time limits to 3 hour metered parking spaces.

# Staff Recommendation

Adopt the Ordinance.

## Fiscal Impact

Two meters will need to be reprogrammed, painted red and decals replaced. Funds are budgeted annually for maintenance of single-spaced meters in the Parking Fund.

## Background

The Village has received a request from the Hemingway District on behalf of the businesses located at 803-805 Lake Street to change three additional metered parking spaces adjacent to their businesses with no time limits to 15 minute metered parking spaces. The UPS Store has recently relocated from the 100 block of N. Marion Street. There are currently two 15 minute meters which were approved by Village Board action on December 5, 2016. This will bring the total to five 15 minute metered spaces on the 800 block of Lake Street.

## Alternatives

The Village Board could direct staff to conduct addition research or suggest an alternative recommendation.

## Previous Board Action

On December 5, 2016, the Village Board of Trustees approved ORD 16-147, changing two parking meters on the 800 block of Lake Street with no time limits to 15 minute metered parking spaces.

On June 16, 2017, the Village Board of Trustees approved ORD 17-230, changing the parking meters with no time limits to 3 hour metered parking spaces.
