An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3 ("Alcoholic Liquor Dealers"), Article 8 ("List of Licenses for Each License Class"), Section 3-8-2 ("Licenses by Name and Address Per License") of the Oak Park Village Code for the Issuance of a Restaurant Class B-4 Liquor License to RG Management Group LLC, DBA Avenue Ale House

Overview

RG Management Group LLC, DBA Avenue Ale House ("RG Management") seeks the issuance of a restaurant B-4 liquor license for the property located at 825 S. Oak Park Avenue.

Staff Recommendation

Adopt the Ordinance.

Fiscal Impact Potential increase in alcoholic liquor dealer's tax.

Background

RG Management seeks the issuance of a restaurant B-4 liquor license for the property located at 825 S. Oak Park Avenue. At its meeting on November 28, 2017, the Liquor Control Review Board ("LCRB") found that RG Management met all of the applicable proposed requirements for the issuance of a B-4 license and recommended that the license be issued by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner. RG Management will succeed MFD Inc. as the licensee at 825 S. Oak Park Avenue for the business known as Avenue Ale House pursuant to its purchase of the business from MFD Inc. Prior to the issuance of the license, the Village Code must be amended to include RG Management as a B-4 licensee.
