An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3 ("Alcoholic Liquor Dealers"), Article 8 ("List of Licenses for Each License Class"), Section 3-8-1 ("Number of Licenses Permitted to be Issued Per License Class") and Section 3-8-2 ("Licenses by Name and Address Per License") of the Oak Park Village Code for the Issuance of a Restaurant Class B-1 Liquor License to Cajun Seafood, Inc.

Overview

Cajun Seafood, Inc. ("Cajun Seafood") seeks the issuance of a Restaurant Class B-1 liquor license for the property located at 1107-1109 South Boulevard.

Staff Recommendation

Adopt the Ordinance.

Fiscal Impact

Potential increase in alcoholic liquor dealer's tax.

Background

Cajun Seafood seeks the issuance of a Restaurant Class B-1 liquor license for the property located at 1107-1109 South Boulevard. At its meeting of September 25, 2018, the Liquor Control Review Board ("LCRB") found that Cajun Seafood met all of the applicable requirements for the issuance of a B-1 license and voted to unanimously recommend that the license be issued by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner. Prior to the issuance of the license, the Village Code must be amended to include Cajun Seafood as a B-1 licensee.
