Agenda Item Title

A Resolution Approving a Purchase Price Agreement with Nettradez, Inc. for the Acquisition of 65 Dell Personal Computers in an Amount Not to Exceed \$50,864.80 and Authorizing Its Execution

Overview

The Information Technology (IT) department is requesting the authorization to purchase sixty-five Dell Optiplex personal computers (PCs) to replace computer equipment used in police department.

Fiscal Impact

Each year, the Village allocates funds for the annual replacement of technology equipment in the Equipment Replacement Fund. The FY 2020 Budget allocated \$79,000.00 for computer equipment replacement (account # 3029.41300.905.570720). Based on the request for quote responses, the total expense for this equipment replacement is \$50,864.00 and is covered under this account.

Background

The IT department is recommending the replacement of older computer equipment currently in use by the Police department. The equipment is at end-of-life and as such does not allow the Village to maintain a uniform equipment standard and is no longer under warranty. The equipment is being phased out to meet technology standards and to support the day-to-day operations of Police personnel and public safety.

A Request for Proposals was sent out February 24, 2020 with eleven vendors responding with complete quotes. Nettradez, Inc. responded with the lowest quote of \$50,864.00.

Alternatives

The Village could elect to not fund this equipment which may result in reduced system security and productivity due to outdated technology.

Previous Board Action

The Board has regularly approved the purchase of new equipment to replace outdated technology through the approved budgeted Equipment Replacement Fund.
