A Resolution Approving and Adopting an Amendment to Section IV ("Compensation") of the Village of Oak Park Personnel Manual to add Juneteenth as an Employee Holiday

Overview

House Bill 3922 was signed into law by Governor Pritzker on June 16, 2021 which recognizes June 19th or "Juneteenth" as National Freedom Day in Illinois. The new law takes effect January 1, 2022.

Background

House Bill 3922 was signed into law by Governor Pritzker on June 16, 2021 and President Biden also signed Senate Bill S 475 designating Juneteenth Independence Day as a federal holiday. Section IV ("Compensation") of the Personnel Manual includes designated holidays observed by the Village of Oak Park.

The State of Illinois has designated Juneteenth a paid holiday only when July 19th falls on a weekday.
