**Agenda Item Title**

**A Resolution Authorizing the Submission of a Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Grant Application with the United States Department of Justice with an Anticipated Funding Amount of \$7,500**

**Overview**

**Background**

Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP), created by the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Act of 1998 is a unique U.S. Department of Justice initiative designed to provide a critical resource to state and local law enforcement. The Police Department purchases vests for new officers and replaces vests every five years. The Police Department is applying for 22 vests equaling a funding total of \$7,500.
